Award Requirements:

- 1) Applicant/Parent must be a member of the PTSA for the 2017/2018 school year.
- 2) Applicant must be a graduating senior and have selected a college/university to attend for the Fall 2018 school year.
- 3) Application must be signed by and submitted to your counselor by the March 30th deadline.
- 4) Applicant must provide a transcript indicating the seventh semester GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 5) Applicant must provide a list of all extracurricular activities AND community service hours for his/her tenure at Greer High School.
- 6) Applicant must compose and submit an essay of no less than 500 words detailing his/her contribution to the advancement of Greer High School and his/her plans after graduation. *Essay should be free of grammatical errors and submitted in double-spaced typed format.
- 7) Applicant must submit one Teacher Recommendation Form with completed application.
