



2020-2021 Frequently Asked Questions

Will students attend career center classes face-to-face?

Students will attend their career center class face-to-face on the one day per week that they are assigned based on the color-coded attendance plan. Students that have elected to participate in the virtual school program are able to take career center classes as well, but must attend face-to-face. Our courses are not provided through the virtual school program.

My student is not scheduled to attend face-to-face on the first day. Will he/she have an assignment the first day?

Yes! All classes begin on Monday, August 24, 2020 for face-to-face and eLearning. Your student should log-in to their google classroom using their Chromebook each day beginning August 24.

Is transportation provided between the career center and home school?

Yes. A shuttle bus is provided daily for students. Contact your home high school to determine the pick-up and drop-off location for this shuttle. Masks are required on all school buses. They will also be assigned seats for travel.

Can my student drive/park at the career center?

Students with a valid driver's license and proof of insurance are able to drive and park at Golden Strip Career Center after they have been approved. This includes an application verification of parent permission, and \$10 fee. This will be enforced beginning August 31, 2020.

Can I ride with my friend that drives to Golden Strip?

Students may ride with other students, only after they have been approved to do so. This includes an application, verification of parent permission, and a \$10 fee. Student drivers are allowed no more than 2 student riders.

Can I pick-up/drop-off my student?

Yes. Use the first parking lot walkway area to pick-up or drop-off. The main loop closest to the building is for buses only.

Can I be added to my student's google classroom account?

Yes, email your student's teacher to be added to their account. Email addresses are found on our website.

If I am not currently enrolled in a google classroom, how do I access my assignments on the first day?

Students that are not yet in a google classroom for their Golden Strip Career Center program should email their career center teacher to be added. Contact information is listed on our website here: https://www.greenville.k12.sc.us/gstripcc/_staff/



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If I am a virtual student but I'm attending career center in-person, what about transportation?

Virtual students may ride the shuttle from their home high school to the career center and back. They may also drive or be dropped off at the career center. (be sure to read section on driving passes)

If a student needs transportation from their HOME address to the high school, they may request this. However, there is NO transportation to a student's home or to the high school midday. It is only provided for the AM bus route and PM bus route. This means that students would have to provide their own transportation at 11:05 AM (at the end of the AM class) or 1:00 PM (to get to the high school for the PM class shuttle).

Are there fees associated with career center class?
