To process all magnet applications fairly, applicants who have been enrolled in private, virtual, home-schools or out-of-district schools (public & charter) must submit records consistent with the records required of applicants enrolled in Greenville County Schools.

It is the parent's responsibility to submit the documentation listed below along with the completed application before the stated deadline. Applications that are incomplete at the time of the first round deadline are eligible for subsequent rounds if the missing documentation is provided. Parents of out-of-district applicants are advised to submit applications early in the application window.

NOTE: If computer-generated report cards, grading scales, attendance, and/or discipline reports are not available, a **school administrator, counselor or home-school instructor must provide the information needed in a signed statement on school letterhead.** The person providing the statement must include contact information for verification purposes. 2019-2020 Report Card (Second Semester - Both 3rd & 4th quarters)

The following **must** appear on the applicant's report card:

- Student's Name - First and last
- Student's Grade Level **(2019-2020)**
- School Year **(2019-2020)**

- Student Grades
 - **3rd & 4th quarter grades or semester grades for all academic and elective classes.** These will be used to calculate the applicant's grade average. Handwriting is not included in the final grade average.
 - **NOTE:** Trimester Grades - 2nd & 3rd grading periods will be used to calculate averages for trimester report cards.
- Grading Scale
 - **NOTE:** If a grading scale does **NOT** appear on the report card, a school administrator, counselor or home-school instructor must provide the grading scale in a signed statement on school letterhead.
- Grade Conversion
 - **Review the following items to determine if your student's grades must be converted:**
 - Only numerical grades 50 -100 and letter grades A, B, C, D, F will be accepted.
 - Grades that are not compatible with Greenville County Schools' grading scale such as Pass/Fail, E/S/U, 1/2/3/4, and narrative summaries **must** be converted to A, B, C, D or F by a school administrator, counselor, or home- school instructor.

2019-2020 Attendance Report (Second Semester – Both 3rd & 4th quarters)

The following information **must** appear on the applicant's attendance report:

- **Absences** – The number of absences that occurred during the second semester of **(2019-2020)**
 - If no absences occurred, a school administrator, counselor or home-school instructor must provide a report indicating "0" absences.
 - If more than 5 absences occurred, provide the dates and reasons for each absence. If not, absences will count as unexcused.
 - If attendance is reported in hours instead of days, convert the hours missed into the number of days missed.

2019-2020 Discipline Report (Second Semester - Both 3rd & 4th quarters)

The following information **must** appear on the applicant's discipline report:

- **Discipline** – The number of referrals that resulted in administrative disciplinary action during the second semester of **(2019-2020)**
