What is Triple P?

A parenting program designed to support families with the management and prevention of behavioral barriers among children and teens. The goal is to empower caregivers with the tools to raise responsible, competent and resilient young people.

What happens at Group Triple P?

Care givers will be able to connect with one another as they discuss their individualized challenges. All participants will be provided with practical tips and suggestions to suit their family's needs.

You will be presented with handouts that incorporate the topics and information discussed in class. This valuable tool can assist with supporting each caregiver as they begin to implement the Triple P approach at home. Your Triple P provider will guide you every step of the way.

How long does it take and how big are the groups?
