

Class Dues FAQs

1. **What are class dues:** Class dues are collected each year. The fees collected are used to pay for class activities associated with school culture and instruction (as directed by the school principal; paperback copy of the book chosen for the School-Wide Book Read in January; 25 prints per month from their Chromebooks. Each class account rolls over to ultimately pay for their Senior Graduation (Timmons Arena rental, programs, and decorations). Last year graduation expenses totaled \$7,000.00.
2. **How much are class dues?** Class dues are \$25 per student (\$5.00 for PIP students)
3. **How can I pay class dues?** Students are encouraged to pay class dues via MySchoolBucks. If that is not possible, students can pay class dues in the library between the hours of 8:15-1pm on the days the school is open. **Credit cards are not accepted at the school.** Please bring cash (exact change) or check made payable to J.L. Mann High School.
4. **Who pays class dues?** All students pay class dues each year. This includes virtual and in-person students.
5. **Can library fees be paid on MySchoolBucks?** No. Because library fees vary greatly from student to student, these fees cannot be paid via MySchoolBucks. Students who owe library fees need to pay those fees in the school library between 8:15-1pm on the days the school is open. **Credit cards are not accepted at the school.** Please bring cash (exact change) or check made payable to J.L. Mann High School.
6. **What if I do not pay my class dues?** Students who do not pay their class dues will have the fees added to the obligation list and that debt will carry all applicable restrictions associated with debts for students.
7. **Is there a technology fee this year?** No. Greenville County Schools waived the technology fee for the 2020-2021 school year.
8. **Are there any other fees that I need to pay?** Maybe. Depending on which classes students take, there may be a fee associated with the class. For example, students who take some science classes are required to pay lab fees. Students who take art classes are required to pay art fees. Students' classroom teachers have notified those who are required to pay fees associated with a particular class.

9. **When was I notified about having to pay class dues?** Information about class dues was given to students at the beginning of the year through 4th-period classes. Additionally, Mr. Mayfield informed students about class dues in his August 30th weekly phone blast.
