- Band: May 8 spring concert included 3 pieces performed by our new Jazz Band club. Good performance by all. S302 passed the state assembly and was signed into law by the governor; it allows a PE credit for marching band.
- MailMann: Articles due May 23 for last issue.
- Guidance: Guidance is busy as AP and EOC testing is underway. Summer school enrollments are being facilitated.
