WeDo Lego Robotics	Rising 2 nd and 3 rd grades	\$50	Monday - Thursday 9:00 am – 12:00 noon June 20-23	Introduction to Lego Robotics and Lego WeDo programming for rising 2 nd and 3 rd grade students. Students will work in small teams to create a variety of interactive projects controlled by student controlled robot programs.
Camp Lego I Robotics	Rising 4 th & 5 th grades	\$85	Monday – Thursday 9:00 am – 12:00 noon June 27-30 -or- July 11-14	Robot design and programming with the Lego EV3 robots. Students will work in teams of two to create and program their robot to compete missions on a defined course. No prior experience is required. Choose from one of two identical sessions.
Camp Lego II Advanced Robotics	Rising 4 th , 5 th & 6 th grades	\$85	Monday – Thursday 9:00 am – 12:00 noon July 18-21	Advanced work with Lego EV3 robots focused on using sensors and advanced programming blocks to complete missions on a defined course. Attendance at Camp Lego I or prior FLL experience required.
Coder Club I	Rising 3 rd -6 th	\$60	Monday – Thursday 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm July 11-14	Learn the basics of computer coding. Students will be exposed to block based visual programming as well as the programming basics in Python and JavaScript. Students will create games, digital art and stories to highlight their new coding skills. No prior experience necessary.
Coder Club II Advanced	Rising 3 rd -6 th	\$60	Monday – Thursday 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm July 18-21	Next step in computer coding. Students will work on more advanced projects with Scratch, Python and JavaScript. Requires attendance at Coder Club I or previous Coding instruction.
STEAM Maker Camp	Rising 2 nd -6 th	\$75	Monday – Thursday 1:00 pm - 4:30 pm July 25-28	Hands-on projects in Science, Tinkering, Engineering, Aesthetics, Mathematics + the Maker Movement. Students will explore by creating a variety of projects in our library MakerSpace. Students will leave exhausted but enthusiastic about learning.
Camp Invention	Rising 1 st – 6 th grades	\$220	Monday - Thursday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm June 27-30	Innovation, creative problem-solving and teamwork are the core of Camp Invention. Young innovators will brainstorm product ideas, explore animals and their environments, create a solar-powered cricket, and much more. ONLINE SIGN UP REQUIRED at CampInvention.org . Urban Naturalist/ Nature Photography	Rising 2 nd -6 th	\$60	Monday-Thursday 9:00 am – 12:00 noon and all day field study FRIDAY 9:00 am – 3:00 pm August 1-5	Students will explore the natural world in our city; topics include plant, animal, and insect identification, being safe in nature, stream water analysis and hiking basics. Students will also be learning the basics of nature photography to document their explorations. On Friday, students will complete a field study to practice naturalist skills and conduct a stream analysis.
Recycled Art	Rising 1 st - 6 th grades	\$40	Monday-Thursday 1:00 – 4:00 pm June 20-23 -or- August 1-4	Students will explore sustainability and art through a variety of recycled art projects. Students will keep all projects created during the course. Choose one of two identical sessions.
