Good afternoon, Mauldin Mighty Eagle Families! This is Mrs. Dodds with the weekly update for April 12-16, 2021. I hope everyone had a great Spring Break. We are excited to welcome our Mighty Eagles back to school tomorrow as we move into the last quarter of the school year.

This Friday, April 16 is an eLearning day. Students will not attend school in the building but should log in to their Chromebook to participate in live lessons with their teacher, and complete assignments throughout the day. Teachers will provide a schedule of lessons for the day on their website and in Google Classroom or SeeSaw. Students who participate in eLearning will be marked present for the day. If you have questions about your child's eLearning schedule or need assistance, please reach out to your child's teacher or call the front office.

Mauldin Elementary will be offering a summer bridge program this summer to help fill in learning gaps caused by the pandemic. Due to limited space, students will be invited to participate based on academic needs. Students invited will receive an invitation and application for the program to go home on Monday. Completed applications must be returned by Friday, April 19, 2021, to secure your child's spot. Based on responses, the second round of invites will go out on Monday, April 19 in grade levels that have space.

As we return from spring break, please remember to reset the alarm so students can be on time for school tomorrow morning. To help students begin their day ready for learning, students should arrive at school in time to be in their classroom by 7:45 when our school day begins. When students are tardy, they miss valuable instruction from the teacher, and students entering the classroom late impact others' learning environment.
