Senior Service Project

All Mauldin High School National Honor Society members will complete a Senior Service Project by the end of their senior year. Members must create a project that will serve and impact the community. Each member is responsible to choose a project which reflects his or her particular interests and talents.

Requirements:

- It is a self-created project. No fund-raisers, profit-sharing, nor volunteering.
- Project requires ten hours of student service.
- Project must be proposed to advisors for approval.
- No more than four NHS members per group.
 - Each student in the group must contribute ten hours **towards** a larger project.
 - ex. a 3-person group would need to complete a 30-hour total project.
- Project must be confirmed by a member of the community (such as a business owner or foundation leader).
- Project must be completed by the due date and presented in the Spring of Senior year.
- Project evidence (pictures, videos, student created materials, etc.)

Deadlines:

- Spring of Junior year: Project Proposals Meetings
- Fall of Senior year: Project Proposals *if* project has changed.
- Winter of Senior year: Mid-year conference
- Spring of Senior year: Project Presentations

Approved Project Ideas:

- Sponsor a book drive for a woman's shelter.
- Create and deliver care packages for the homeless.
- Organize a drive for pet items needed at the Humane Society.
- Decorate cookies with the elderly at a nursing home.
- Organize a 5k to raise Autism awareness.
- Sponsor a drive for school supplies for students in need.
- Create a buddy program for students with special needs in the school.

Examples of Not Approved Projects:

- Volunteer at a soup kitchen.
- Adopt-a-Highway.
- Profit-share at a restaurant for a cause.
- Buying and re-selling items for a cause.
