

Northwest Middle Beta Club Contract

Below is a list of the requirements that must be met in order to maintain your membership in the club as well as the consequences of not meeting these obligations:

-Attendance at monthly general meetings is mandatory. If you cannot attend a meeting due to a schedule conflict, you must attend an alternate meeting at 7:50 am in the media center the following morning. Two missed unexcused meetings remove you from further participation. Fall meetings are currently scheduled for November 3 and December 1. Spring meeting dates will be announced.

-Discipline referrals remove you from participation.

-All students must maintain a cumulative average of 85 or above and have no quarterly grade below a 77. Failure to maintain grades for one quarter puts you on probation for the following quarter. If grades are not improved to the acceptable level in the next quarter, you are removed from participation.

-Students must be picked up on time. Students whose ride is not at Northwest by 15 minutes after the announced end time for a meeting are placed on probation. The second time your ride is more than 15 minutes late, you are removed from further participation.

-Dues in the amount of \$10 per year are normally collected to pay for snacks for meetings. You must pay dues by the November 3rd meeting in order to continue to participate. Ms. Burgs will receipt dues in the mornings before school. Please see Ms. Burgs with further questions.

-Beta Club students are required to perform and turn in documentation of community service hours in the amount of 25 hours per year. Forms are available on the Northwest web site or from the media center. Documentation of hours must be turned in to Mrs. Reaney in the Media Center **at the first Beta Club meeting following report card distribution**. To ensure that service hours are performed throughout the year, all students must turn in **10** or more hours by the **December 1st meeting**. The final 15 hours will be due by **Wednesday, May 3, 2017**. Late hours will not be accepted for any reason. Try to turn your hours in early so that you avoid any complications such as an absence. Some service hour opportunities will be discussed at meetings and some service hours will be performed at monthly meetings. However, service hours are not limited to the ones discussed or performed at meetings. If you have a question about whether service counts toward your Beta Club requirements, please see Mrs. Reaney.

-You must bring this signed contract back to Mrs. Reaney or Ms. Burgs **before** the next Beta Club meeting on **November 3rd**. Failure to return the signed contract removes you from further participation.
