SICK OR NOT SICK?

When a child is not feeling well, parents face uncertainty about whether to send him or her to school. Here are some general guidelines that can help.



- To come to school, students must be fever-free for 24 hours without medication. A fever is a temperature of 100.4 or greater.
- Students who have been vomiting or who have diarrhea should not be sent to school until they are symptom-free for 24 hours.
- When in doubt, it is better to err on the side of safety.
