The building opens at 7:15 am. Please do not drop off children before that time. No staff member is available to supervise them before 7:15 and they will not be able to get into the building before that time.

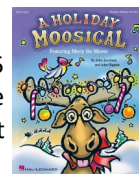

SEND YOUR CHILD BIRTHDAY WISHES



Want to wish your child "Happy Birthday" on the Paris LED sign? You may have noticed some of the birthday wishes already. The cost is \$10 per recognition. Payment and sign up links can be found on the Paris PTA website. The recognized birthday must be for a student enrolled at Paris Elementary. Siblings who are not enrolled at Paris and other family members or friends are not eligible. Birthday greetings on the sign are a PTA fundraiser used to pay for school programs and needs. SICK OR NOT SICK?

When a child is not feeling well, parents face uncertainty about whether to send him or her to school. Here are some general guidelines that can help.



- To come to school, students must be fever-free for 24 hours *without* medication. A fever is a temperature of 100.4 or greater.
- Students who have been vomiting or who have diarrhea should not be sent to school until they are symptom-free for 24 hours.
- When in doubt, it is better to err on the side of safety.
