INTERNATIONAL WALK AT SCHOOL DAY

So far over 2,900 schools have registered to participate in this event, with forty-nine states represented. We want to get involved and do our part to promote safe walking and fitness. We look forward to seeing you on the track on October 2, at 7:15 am.

STAY WELL AND PROSPER...

Cold and Flu season is here....These are just a few tips to slow or prevent the spread of seasonal influenza and keep our school healthy.

- ⇒ Check your child for flu symptoms. Symptoms of flu can include fever, runny nose, body aches, headaches, feeling tired, or a combination of symptoms.
- ⇒ Keep your child home if he/she has a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher. Your child needs to be fever free (temperature less than 100.4) for 24 hours without medicine before they return to school.
- ⇒ Children with the flu will need to stay home until the fever is gone for 24 hours without taking medicines to reduce fever. The usual time is 3-5 days.
- ⇒ Practice frequent hand washing with soap and water and covering your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze.
- ⇒ If symptoms present as nausea and vomiting your child should remain home for at least 24 hours after the last episode of vomiting.
- ⇒ Please let us know if your child tests positive for the flu.
