Early Dismissal Procedures:

- Bring a Parent Note to the front office upon arrival to school on the day of the dismissal.
- You will receive a dismissal slip as your pass out of class at the Pre-Arranged Time.
- Forgot your note?? Come to the office anyway!!
- Students without pre-arranged dismissals will be released at class change to limit class interruptions.
- Only pre-arranged dismissals after last class change.

In order for students to take their devices home, parents must complete the One to One Device process and pay the annual \$25 technology fee.
