



Why orchestra?

- Experts have concluded that the study of music helps with spatial reasoning, test taking, and overall quality of life!
- Participation develops teamwork, responsibility, social skills, emotional development, leadership training, group interaction, aesthetic perception, and discipline.
- Orchestra offers performance options throughout the school year with opportunities to participate in chamber ensembles, as well as all-county, region and all-state competitions.
- Multiple opportunities to attend field trips throughout the year including professional performances, Carowinds, and overnight trips.
- Working toward a common goal links students with a group of friends they will share a bond with throughout their high school career and beyond.

Common Parent Questions:

What is the Block Schedule and how does it work with Orchestra?

In this type of schedule, each student has fewer classes per day and each class is meets for a longer period of time than other schedules (e.g. 90 minutes instead of 50). Students take 4 classes per semester, and 8 total per year. This allows for earning 32 potential credits, but only 24 are required to graduate. That means taking orchestra, which is a year-long class, as 2 of the 8 classes for the year doesn't cause issues with meeting other requirements.
