# **Attendance and Early Dismissals**

Dear Parents.

We are so thankful for the supportive parents of Sevier students. Our children are happy, focused, and learning — preparing for what lies ahead. Attendance is a big part of that preparation.

When a student misses school, they miss a lot. Content and skills learned through make-up tasks, without face to face instruction, is often lacking in depth and quality. The challenge of multiple assignments to be completed as instruction in new concepts unfolds can be daunting for any student.

As Winter Break approaches, we must emphasize student focus on learning responsibilities. Classes continue to move forward with challenging curriculum and there is much to accomplish before the end of the 2nd Quarter on January 14. Please support your child's academic success by minimizing school absences and early dismissals.

Please know, per Greenville County School policy, that a referral must be issued and a Parent/ Student Intervention Conference required after 3 consecutive unverified or unexcused absences, or a total of 5 unverified or unexcused absences. An unverified absence is one without a parent or doctor note. Unexcused absences include family vacations or events, leaving town, lack of transportation, car trouble, etc.

Even so, students who are ill should not come to school. To minimize the spread of viruses, district policy states that students with a fever are considered contagious and may not return to school until they are fever free without medicine for 24 hours.

If an early dismissal cannot be avoided, please follow procedures — send a note before 1st period. Dismissals that are not pre-arranged will require that the student to be dismissed during class change, when the front office can call into the room.
