What is AVID?

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) is a College Readiness System that works to ensure students are college-ready by equipping them with the skills, academic behaviors, and college knowledge necessary to succeed. AVID helps students develop a vision for their future, gain confidence in their abilities, and take ownership of their learning

What does "College Readiness" mean?

College-ready students can:

- understand what is expected in a college course.
- cope with the content knowledge presented.
- take away from the course key intellectual lessons, and
- have both the mindset and disposition necessary to enable understanding.

Profile of an AVID Student:

AVID students are on the college track, and will design a long-range plan which requires them to enroll in rigorous courses, such as Honors, IB, Dual Credit, and/or Advanced Placement, ultimately earning at least 6 college credits before they graduate.

Goals of the Summer Bridge Institute:

To support them in their rigorous coursework, AVID students will learn organizational and study skills, develop critical thinking, learn to ask probing questions, receive academic planning advice from college admissions counselors, tour several college campuses, and participate in enrichment and motivational activities to make their college dreams a reality
