Understanding the Dual Enrollment Program:		
Parent & Student MUST initial each item confirming understanding of implications & requirements of Dual Enrollment Programs:		
/Dropping a Class - Students and parent/guardian agree that they will not request to drop any dual enrollment course at any point after the University/College predetermined course drop date. If withdrawing, the student would still be subject to the University/Colleges terms regarding course withdrawals and The South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy/GPA/Grading - Students completing a dual enrollment course receive credit and corresponding grades for both their high school and		
college transcripts. In most cases, the high school credit is weighted at the Dual Credit level as assigned by the SC Uniform Grading Policy. Students and parents understand that they are beginning their post-secondary transcript. Poor performance, failure, or withdrawal from a dual enrollment course can effect athletic eligibility during the following semester.		
/Attendance - Students are expected to follow all applicable college attendance expectations. In some cases, this may result in a student missing a school sponsored assembly, trips, etc.		
/ Transportation – For Dual Enrollment courses taught off high school campus the student and parents/guardian is responsible for transportation to the appropriate University/College Campus.		
Course Request - The student's school counselor must approve all coursework prior to enrolling in all college-level course work. If a student is taking a dual enrollment course to fulfill a core graduation requirement, then the student's school counselor must give approval.		
Accommodations- Any students with accommodations like a 504, ILAP, or IEP needs to go through the College/University Student Disability Services and their process, if they wish to have accommodations in their dual credit courses.		
Course Content - The syllabus and content for college level courses is set and dictated by the college. We encourage parents to review the syllabus to ensure they are comfortable with their child engaging in the content of the course. Because the content is created by the college, no alternative assignments will be provided since the course is under the purview of the college and not Greenville County Schools
