Applications that are incomplete at the time of the first round deadline are eligible for subsequent rounds if the missing documentation is provided. Parents of out-of-district applicants are advised to <u>submit applications early</u> in the application window.

NOTE: If computer-generated report cards, grading scales, attendance, and/or discipline reports are not available, **a school** administrator, counselor or home-school instructor must provide the information needed in a signed statement on school letterhead. The person providing the statement must include contact information for verification purposes. See additional directions below:
