*In District 1st & 2nd GRADE Applicants – No additional documents are required. Magnet coordinators will use fall FastBridge assessment scores to evaluate your student's progress toward on-grade level academic goals.

*Out of District 1st & 2nd GRADE Applicants – Please contact the school's magnet coordinator to schedule a magnet assessment. Magnet assessments will occur virtually and last 5-10 minutes. If your student is applying to more than one magnet academy, you must submit a separate application to each academy, but you may complete the assessment at only one of the academies. 4th GRADE Applicants – Provide the student's 2nd GRADE END OF YEAR REPORT CARD 2019-2020. Report card should include 3nd-4th quarter grades, attendance & discipline reports for the year.

5th GRADE Applicants – Provide the student's 3rd GRADE END OF YEAR REPORT CARD 2019-2020. Report card should include 3rd-4th quarter grades, attendance & discipline reports for the year.

OUT OF DISTRICT ONLY - If a grading scale does not appear on the report card, the <u>parent must</u> request the current school convert grades to align with the GCS system. Review the following to determine if your student's grades must be converted:

*GRADE CONVERSION GUIDELINES:

- All academic grades in math, science, language arts, reading and social studies will be used to calculate the applicant's grade average.
 Related Arts Classes can also be included, but Penmanship/Handwriting is not included in the final grade average.
- Only numerical grades 50 -100 and letter grades A, B, C, D, F that include the school's grading scale will be accepted.
- Grades that are not compatible with Greenville County School's grading scale such as Pass/Fail, E/S/U, 1/2/3/4, and narrative summaries - must be converted by the current school to numerical grades.

OUT OF DISTRICT ONLY - 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade Applicants

If computer-generated report cards, grading scales, attendance, and/or discipline reports are not available, a school administrator, counselor or home-school instructor must provide the information needed in a signed statement on school letterhead. The person providing the statement must include contact information for verification purposes. See additional directions below:

- o <u>Must include</u> 1) student's first and last name 2) grade level 3) academic year and 4) school name.
- o <u>Must align</u> with the required grading period for the magnet application.
- ATTENDANCE Proide the number of absences that occurred within the applicant's required grading period.
 - o If no absences occurred, provide a report indicating "0" absences.
 - o If more than 5 absences occurred, provide the dates and reasons for each absence. If not, absences will count as unexcused.
 - o If attendance is reported in hours instead of days, convert the hours missed into the number of days missed.
- DISCIPLINE Provide the number of referrals that resulted in disciplinary action at the administrative level.
