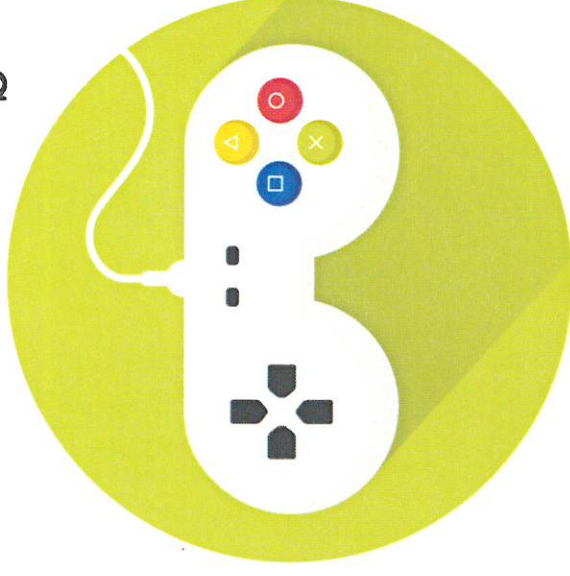

Expectations

Homework:

This year in 5th grade, your child will be expected to read every night, at least 20 minutes. Students will need to have their **reading logs signed every night**. Math, Social Studies, and Science homework may be assigned Monday-Thursday nights. Students are expected to complete homework every night, and have it ready to turn in the next day.

Red Folders:

Each student will receive a red folder to bring home important information and to hold homework. Students are expected to bring this to and from school every day. If lost, another will need to be purchased. Even though your child is in 5th grade, we still encourage you to check this nightly for home to school communication.

Chromebooks

Students and parents will be required to sign a contract with Chromebook expectations. Students will be using Chromebooks for educational purposes only. Using the chromebooks will be a privilege that can be taken away if the contract is broken. When taken home they will need to be charged and returned daily in order to complete school work!

Summer

Reading:

Students should continue to read during summer break. This will help keep them on grade level!

Math:

Students can login to their IXL account with their student login. They can practice any lessons, especially multiplication, division, and fractions for 5th grade.
