Alive at 25 is a program of the **Southeastern Chapter National Safety Council (SCNSC)**, the same nonprofit organization that provides point reduction training for the

state of South Carolina. Launched in 2007, the Alive at 25 program focuses on behavior, judgment, decision making and consequences to provide young drivers with tools for making positive choices behind the wheel. This unique defensive driving program is taught by local law enforcement officers in a single 4.5 hour class session.
