Painted Parking Spot Guidelines/Application



Cost \$25.00 (Separate from your parking pass) – does not include supplies (paint, brushes, etc.)

1. Parking space painting will take place on **Saturday, August 14, and September 25, 2021, 8 am-3 pm.** You cannot start before 8 am. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** The student parking lots will be closed to through traffic during the painting time.
2. All designs must be approved prior to painting. A copy of your design must be included with the signed application. Clearly draw the design and include the colors you will be using. Please submit the application and design for approval to: trhsboosterclub2019@gmail.com. Applications and guidelines are available for download via TRHS Booster Club Facebook and by emailing the Booster Club at trhsboosterclub2019@gmail.com.
3. Students will be notified by the Booster Club or administration if their design is not acceptable. **You must follow the approved design exactly on painting day – NO changes are allowed.**
4. Students must provide their own water-based, latex paint and supplies. Water-based exterior latex paint is recommended and can be found at home improvement, hardware, and paint stores.
 - a. NO spray paint
 - b. NO reflective paint
 - c. NO fluorescent paint
 - d. NO oil-based paint
 - e. NO glitter
 - f. NO clear coat
5. Students are required to clean up their area (including paint and brushes) when they are finished painting.
6. **DO NOT COVER THE WHITE LINES OR NUMBER OF THE PARKING SPACE.** Students must leave 4 inches between the white lines and the design. It is advisable to tape this border off when painting.
7. **All parking spaces MUST be painted over with white paint prior to your last day of school.** Senior's spaces must be painted over. Failure to do so may interfere with your graduation walk.
8. Designs must be school appropriate. The following items are prohibited:
NO offensive picture, flag, or symbol
NO negative, offensive, or rude language
NO "gang-style" tagging
NO double meaning words or phrases
NO nicknames, no girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. (ONLY your name or initials permitted)
NO Political Statements

Note: Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Principal, Assistant Principal, Resource Officer, or Booster Club. Disciplinary action may be taken and you may forfeit your right to an assigned parking space. Students will not be allowed to alter their spots after the designated painting day.

Suggested Materials, Tips, and Hints

Check-in upon arrival with your application form & approved design

WATER based primer paint & base coat paint, if desired

Chalk to sketch design

Paint roller extension

Paint pans or plastic containers for water, paint, and brushes

Painters tape (4 inches wide)

A plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans

Broom and/or dust blower to sweep spots, if needed

Old cloths or paper towels

Trash bag (for your trash)

Sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, shade, drink, snacks, etc.

Lawn chair, stool, a towel to sit on
