#### FIRST IN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The George Rogers Foundation was founded in an effort to provide scholarships for first in family students in need of financial assistance to purse a college education.

#### **Eligibility Criteria** - Applicant must be a:

- √ South Carolina Resident
- ✓ First in Family student defined as a student who will be the first person in their family to attend a 2 or 4 year college
- ✓ Graduating high school senior Applicants must submit:
- ✓ An official transcript indicating a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better,

#### and provide:

- ✓ Admissions acceptance letter. Unfortunately, students applying to online or proprietary schools are not eligible
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation from a high school/college faculty member, school counselor, employer, or church leader ✓ One letter of affirmation from a parent/guardian stating the applicant is the first person in his/her family to attend college

**Award Criteria:** Scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievements and honors, extracurricular and volunteer participation, work experience and short answer responses.

Deadline to Apply: March 16, 2018

The intention of this unrestricted scholarship is to provide financial assistance to high school seniors looking to attend post-high school education and pursue a field in science or mathematics. The scholarship amount is **\$2,000** and will be presented directly to the student.

#### **Guidelines:**

- 1. Recipient must be a high school senior.
- Recipient must have achieved at least an 85 average on the SC Uniform Grading Scale (SCUGS) for all classes. (3.0 on a 4.0 scale)
- 3. Recipient must have achieved at least a **90 average** across all science courses on the SCUGS. (3.5 on a **4.0 scale**)
- 4. Recipient must **maintain behavior that is acceptable** to the guidelines of their respective High School.

5.	In 1000 words or less recipient should answer <b>two</b> of
	the three following essay questions. Essays should be
	written as a single response and not two separate
	responses.

- a. What about science or math interests you?
- b. Why is the study of science and mathematics important for the future?
- c. What contribution to society do you see yourself making through a career in science or math?

Essays will be submitted electronically for evaluation. Please coordinate with your school counselor in order to submit an electronic copy of your essay. <u>Evaluation</u>:

- Essays will be evaluated using the following rubric:
  - 20% Grammar
  - o 20% Creativity
  - o 30% Relevance to science and math
  - o 30% Tone that is current and forward thinking

Applications are available from Ms. Fleming in Guidance and are due back to Ms. Fleming by March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
