

Individual Graduation Plans

Individual graduation plans begin in 8th grade and updated each year in high school. An Individual Graduation Plan is a road map that guides students toward their education, career and employment goals. IGPs include general graduation requirements, as well as coursework and out-of-classroom learning opportunities related to a student's chosen cluster of study. IGPs also help students align high school courses with college entrance requirements. Still, these plans are flexible and can change based on a student's aspirations, abilities and interests. Parents are invited to attend your student's IGP meeting. You will receive information when your student's counselor begins scheduling meetings to contact her so you can attend.
