NCAA Eligibility Center

Student-athletes who wish to play sports in college will need to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center, formally the Clearinghouse. Student-athletes should begin registering in the spring of their junior year by creating an account at www.eligibilitycenter.org and following the directions. You will need to print off the transcript request form and bring it to your school counselor so your transcript will be mailed at the end of your junior year, which will begin the process of determining eligibility.

Please Note: The National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) has very strict guidelines regarding credit for courses taken online, such as courses offered by the Greenville County and South Carolina Virtual School programs. Many online courses ARE NOT APPROVED by the NCAA. Before enrolling in any online class be sure to consult with your high school's athletic director and your guidance counselor to determine if the online course that you are considering is approved for credit by the NCAA.
