

SAT and ACT

- The ACT and SAT are college admissions tests. Most colleges require the scores from at least one exam. If possible, we recommend trying each test at least once so you can decide which test you like better and see how you performed on each exam.
- You must register online for each exam. You will create an account which you will use throughout high school to register and check exam scores—remember your login information!!
- You must use our school code, 411985, when registering.
- Colleges will not accept scores from your counselor. When you register, each exam will allow four colleges to receive your score report for free. If you want additional scores sent or you decide to apply to a college who did not originally receive your score, you will be charged for extra score reports and will need to request these online.
- Greenville Tech does not require SAT/ACT scores.
- December of your senior year is usually the last testing date for both the SAT and the ACT that colleges can receive scores in time to make an admissions decision.

The SAT

Visit the SAT website, www.collegeboard.org to register for the test. This website also has a lot of information regarding college and financial aid searches. Colleges will super score SAT scores which means they will use the highest math, reading, and writing scores, even if they come from different testing administrations. Please check their website for registration deadlines and testing dates.

The ACT

Registration for the ACT can be found at www.act.org. If you take this exam more than one time, you only need to take the writing portion once. Please check their website for registration deadlines and testing dates.

Fee Waivers!

If you qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch you are eligible for a SAT/ACT fee waiver. Each student can receive a maximum of 2 fee waivers for each exam. If you are eligible and use a SAT fee waiver, you are also eligible to receive up to 4 college application fee waivers. You will complete the college application fee waivers online through your collegeboard account. See your counselor for more information.

Taking the Exam Again??? You still need to send your applications to the colleges. Indicate on your application the dates you will take the exam (as well as the dates you have taken) the SAT/ACT. The colleges will know to look for these scores. DO NOT WAIT ON SAT/ACT SCORES TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS.
