- 3. Sirrine Scholarships are awarded for a maximum of four years for undergraduate study at a two- or four-year institution. Sirrine Scholarships are renewable for a maximum of three years, provided the student maintains satisfactory progress toward the completion of his/her program of studies and is recommended for renewal by the institution he/she attends. Renewals are not automatic; the student must reapply each year, and his/her renewal award may be less or greater than his/her original award, depending upon the financial need.
