1. The J. E. Serrine Scholarship Program is administered by Greenville County Schools (SC) for the benefit of its high school students graduating in 2013 and subsequent years.
2. **Scholarship payments will be divided into two equal checks made payable to the institution. The first check will be mailed to arrive by August 1st and the second check to arrive by December 1st. After these dates, questions regarding your scholarship payments should be directed to the financial aid office at the institution.**
3. Serrine Scholarships are awarded for a maximum of four years for undergraduate study at a two- or four-year institution. Serrine Scholarships are renewable for a maximum of three years, provided the student maintains satisfactory progress toward the completion of his/her program of studies and is recommended for renewal by the institution he/she attends. Renewals are not automatic; the student must reapply each year, and his/her renewal award may be less or greater than his/her original award, depending upon the financial need.
