A Word from Mrs. Ketron

Greenville County Schools has adopted a new procedure for screening school volunteers. The main goal in using these new procedures is to ensure safety for our students. Parents or volunteers will be asked to complete a form that collects some basic information from them. There will be two groups or types of volunteers.

- <u>Level I volunteers</u> work in the schools under the direction of school staff. Level I volunteers simply complete the form and sign-in and out each time they come to our school.
- <u>Level II volunteers</u> can be used as chaperones on field trips or work
 with students one-on-one. <u>If a parent wants to attend a field trip,</u>
 they have to be a <u>Level II Volunteer!</u> Level II volunteers complete
 the application AND complete an on-line application which permits

- a background check to be completed. Once the school receives approval from the district office, that volunteer can be a Level II Volunteer.
- You can find a copy of the Volunteer form and access to the online portion on our school website on the Title I page under the Volunteer tab.

We have the volunteer forms in our school office and computer access to assist parents and volunteers in completing the on-line portion.
