- May 21 Science (grade 4) & Social Studies(grade 5)

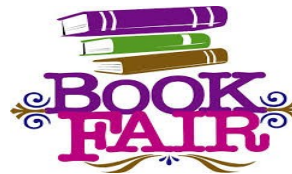
## Spring Dance April 12
