Greenville County Schools has a specific procedure for screening school volunteers to ensure safety for our students. There are types of volunteers: level 1 or level 2. Parents and volunteers can access the volunteer application through the school's website under the parent links section. Simply click the link and complete the on-line application. You will need an email address, Social Security number, and driver's license. All school visitors and volunteers will need to show an I.D. when signing in. Be sure to apply early if you want to go on field trips!
