## Third Grade Supply List

- Book bag no rollers
- ❖ 3 packs of No.2 yellow pencils (no designer pencils please) Total 24 pencils
- ❖ 3 poly-vinyl (plastice) pocket folders with prongs one red, one blue, one green
- 2 packs of wide ruled notebook paper
- \* 3 marble composition notebooks (wide ruled)
- ❖ 1 pack of colored <u>copy paper</u> (this is not construction paper)
- 1 pack of colored <u>card stock</u> paper
- ❖ 1 pack of white copy paper
- Crayons (no more than 24)
- 3 large boxes of tissues
