

STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students are expected to keep themselves well-groomed and neatly dressed at all times. Any form of dress or hairstyle, which is considered contrary to good hygiene or which is distracting or disruptive, will not be permitted. The following are the dress code rules:

Shirts:

SOLID WHITE WITH A COLLAR

- Shirts may not have stripes on collar or sleeves
- Turtleneck shirts are permitted.
- Shirts may not have a hood.
- Long sleeve or short sleeve t-shirts may NOT be worn over dress code shirts.
- Shirts with cowl or scoop neck may NOT be worn
- Boys' shirts must remain tucked in at all times while on campus or fieldtrips.
- Girls must have all of their mid-section covered by their shirts.
- Girls may NOT tie up their shirts in the front or back.
- Girls that wear shirts longer than finger-tip length must also tuck shirt in.
- No tank tops or spaghetti-strap shirts may be worn over dress code shirts.
- All shirts worn under dress code shirts must be solid white.

Pants, Skirts, Dresses or Shorts:

SOLID KHAKI PANTS, SKIRTS, OR SHORTS

- Jeans (denim) of any color may NOT be worn.
- Pants, dresses, skirts and shorts must be hemmed and not have a ragged hem.
- Overalls, pants with drawstrings, or athletic shorts MAY NOT BE WORN UNDER UNIFORM PANTS.
- Pants, shorts and skirts must be worn with the waistline above the hips at all times.
- Pants cannot be tucked in socks or drag on the floor.
- Oversize garments may not be worn.
- Skirts and shorts must be finger-tip length to the knee.
- Tights or leggings cannot be worn.
- Tying items other than belts around the waist is not permitted.

Outerwear, Shoes, Hats, Piercing and Accessories:

- Hooded sweatshirts, hooded jackets, hooded vests, hooded fleece, and hooded sweaters and coats may NOT be worn in the classrooms.
- All coats will be stored with the students' personal possessions in the office. Coats will remain stored until afternoon dismissal.
- Black belts must be worn if garments were made with belt loops.
- No large belt buckles may be worn.
- All belts must be worn at the waist.
- Long socks pulled up may not be worn with shorts or skirts. Mismatched or two pairs of socks of different colors are not allowed.
- No logos (other than on the shirt pocket area), writing, or pictures are permitted on garments.
- Proper black shoes must be worn at all times. Flip flops or shower shoes, high heels or sandals are NOT allowed.

- Hats and sunglasses may not be worn in the building.
- Small earrings are permitted to be worn only on the ears of females only.
- No bandanas, skullies, “do-rags”, sweatbands or sunglasses may be worn or be visible while at school.

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS:

- Students will contact parents to bring proper attire.
- Students not in compliance with the dress code will not be allowed to attend classes until properly attired.
- Continual violation of the dress code could result in suspension.

**All determinations regarding uniform acceptability will be the sole determination of administration.*
