## Please note:

- All students who were scheduled to test on October 29 are automatically included in testing
- All students who were scheduled to test on October 14 but were unable to do so will automatically be included in testing.

(These students do not need to reregister).

Students enrolled in Greenville County Schools Virtual Program are required to provide their own transportation. Per College Board policies, students who took the PSAT/NMSQT test on October 14, 2020, are not eligible for testing on January 26.
