The administration of the school has final say when activities or clubs will be scheduled.

Guidelines

1. Students will only be allowed to participate in two clubs whose meeting times have no conflict. (see above Club Meeting Schedule)
2. Students are encouraged to apply for as many clubs as they wish. They will only be selected for two clubs whose meeting times do not conflict.

3. Clubs that require auditions will begin their selection process in early March. The remainder of the clubs will accept applications after the audition process.
4. Students are responsible for completing all club application without parent assistance. Parents will receive a separate permission to complete during the application process.
5. All club applications will be assessed based on a pre-approved rubric.
6. All unexcused tardies, dismissals, and absences will be considered during the selection process.
7. All application and auditions will be considered confidential.
8. A prioritized waiting list will be created for qualified students not accepted into clubs.
9. Newly enrolled students will be able to audition for DRUM, Chorus, or Art Club if interested. They may also apply for any other club and if they meet qualifications will be placed on the prioritized waiting list.
10. All final selections will be approved by administration.
